

Lesson Name: Click Clack Moo I Can Type Too!

Instructional Objective:

The Learner Will (TLW)...

- use a mouse effectly.
- display a comprehension of the book through the use of technology.
- complete a quiz online via Photopeach a Web 2.0 tool.

Materials and Media:

- Computer
- Internet connection
- A pre-made Photopeach quiz for students to complete.

Lesson

Set:

We are reading Click Clack Moo today. After we read the book we will complete a fun online quiz. The quiz is going to focus on the main events in the story. Everyone will need to pay special attention so they can complete the quiz successfully.

Instruction:

The teacher will read aloud to the class Click Clack Moo by Doreen Cronin. Before reading the book the teacher will tell the class about the Photopeach quiz. The teacher will ask the students to pay particular attention to the main events in the story.

Closure:

The students will use the Photopeach quiz to demonstrate the understanding of the lesson's objective. Students can use the same technology on a future read aloud book. The students can brainstorm questions with the teacher in a class-wide discussion.

Reflection of Candidate:

The lesson went well. The students enjoyed using the computers for a reading lesson. I incorporated some funny pictures which made the students laugh. Photopeach provided an opportunity to make learning fun and engaging. the lesson also provided the students a chance to practice reading. Overall, I think the students learned about the
